Dr Duygu Camurcuoglu ACR, FIIC has completed an MA, MSc and a PhD in Conservation/Material Science at UCL. She has been working as an inorganic objects conservator at the British Museum over 10 years. She also worked as the head conservator at the renowned Neolithic site of Catalhoyuk for 8 seasons, supporting the site to win 'World Heritage Site' status, as well as a number of students and colleagues through their career development. Duygu has been involved with ICON as a Trustee as well as a PACR assessor/mentor and actively collaborates with international institutions, such as IIC and ICOM-CC organising large scale conferences. Duygu is interested in research, building international relationships and career development in Conservation. She gives lectures for conservation courses at various universities and takes part in designing and delivering training programmes at the British Museum, i.e. Iraq Training Programme. Duygu was a part of the team who won the Nigel Williams Prize in 2019.

Dr Duygu Camurcuoglu ACR, FIIC 擁有倫敦大學學院(University College London)修護雙碩士學位與材料科學博士學位。她擔任大英博物館無機物修護師，至今年資已超過 10 年。她曾任新石器時代遺址 Catalhoyuk 的首席修護師，協助該遺址被列入教科文組織世界遺產，並協助學生與同事之職涯發展。她是 ICON 董事、PACR 評分者及導師。她積極參與國際機構或學會間的合作，例如 IIC 和 ICOM-CC，及籌劃大型學術研討會。她熱衷於研究、修護界的國際間交流與修護師的職涯發展。她在數間大學的修護學程中授課，並規劃及執行大英博物館的培訓課程，如伊拉克培訓計畫。她是贏得 2019 年 Nigel Williams Prize 獎項的團隊一員。
